The Fourth Degree - The Patriotic Degree of Our Order

The primary purpose of the Fourth Degree is to foster the spirit of patriotism by promoting responsible citizenship and a love of and loyalty to the Knights' respective countries through membership in local Fourth Degree groups called Assemblies.

Starting at the Supreme level there is the Supreme Master and the Supreme Board of Directors. The next level of the structure is broken into provinces of which there are twenty. Each province is lead by a Vice-Supreme Master. Our Province covers Washington, Oregon, & Idaho. Our Vice-Supreme Master is Wayne Hogan. The province is then broken up into districts each of which contains a Master. Our Oregon District Master is Carroll Gorg. The district contains the local Assemblies including our Assembly, Archbishop Dwyer Assembly #1292.

Certain members of the Fourth Degree serve as Color Guards and Honor Guards at civic and religious functions, an honorable activity which has brought worldwide recognition to the Knights of Columbus and local Assembly organizations.
