**ARCHBISHOP DWYER ASSEMBLY MEMORIAL  
 FUND**

All Sir Knights in good standing (paid up dues) upon their passing are eligible for a perpetual memorial from the assembly. The assembly takes 10% of each year's membership dues and places it in the Memorial Account. Until the last few years the Sir Knights options were 1. The Grotto, 2. The Jesuits, 3. Maryknoll, 4. Mt. Angel and 5. The Franciscans. Recently 6. credit toward the purchase of a chalice was added.

For years the amount given to the Sir Knights choice for their perpetual remembrance was \$50. With the rise in costs and inflation, the assembly voted to increase the amount to \$100. For those wishing to have a chalice, \$100 will be credited towards the purchase of a chalice. At the present time Supreme is selling chalices at \$300 so the chalice would cost the Sir Knight or his family \$200. With ever increasing inflation, some Sir Knight's are pre-purchasing their chalices to beat any future price increases. A wooden, black leatherette, lined case is also available for an extra \$85. Purchased chalices may be stored at the assembly or given to the Sir Knight at the time of purchase.

Several Sir Knight's have not indicated a choice of the six (6) options. Please contact Faithful Comptroller to be sure we have your choice or to purchase a chalice if you wish.
